LOCATION:

Sulphur Prospecting Permit No. 68, containing 97,230 acres, is located in Northeastern Alberta, Townships 103 & 104, Ranges 23 & 24 West 4th Meridian.

FIELD OPERATIONS:


Seismic field party 5, operating for Shell Canada Limited, carried out the drilling of 504 seismic shot holes over the permit area during December 1967 and January 1968. The holes, which are spaced 200 feet apart, were drilled to a maximum depth of 60 feet by truck mounted 3-1/2 inch auger drills. Enclosure No. 1 shows the location of the auger holes drilled.

Drillers logs were later examined for indications of sulphur.

No sulphur was reported.
