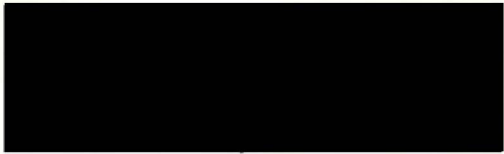

Two mosaics covering Permit No. 128 were obtained from the Department of Lands & Forests in Edmonton, Alberta and the combined annotated mozaic is included here. The outline of Permit No. 128 is shown on the attached print.

The areas of interest are those which are devoid of vegetation possibly caused by sulphur in sufficient concentration.

The area of maximum interest from air-photo interpretation is in Section 32, Township 115, Range 2, W5th. shown on the mosaic as "S". It is recommended that surface samples and surface inspection be obtained in the general area indicated.

do solemnly declare that The property was examined by a
helicopter-borne party (two men and a pilot) from Calgary
in March 1968 who landed on the property at the points
marked "X" and drilled several (4) holes in that area with
a light power-driven auger.

None of the samples would burn with the flame from a butane
torch when dried, indicating an absence of sulphur. This
is the result of the field examination of the property.
