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FINAL REPORT ON SULPHUR EXPLORATION SULPHUR PROSPECTING PERMIT NO. 64 TWP. 108, 109, RGE. 2, 3 W5M

Sulphur Prospecting Permit No. 64 (39,680 acres) was acquired by Texaco Exploration on December 18, 1967 and renewed for six months on December 18, 1968. Exploration on the Permit was conducted during January 1969 and consisted of one hundred fifty twelve foot deep auger holes drilled at 1,000 foot intervals along existing trails and seismic lines. Two samples were taken from each hole and a qualitative test for sulphur and semiquantitative test for water soluble sulphate were made on each sample. No sulphur was detected in any of the 300 samples and sulphate contents were too variable to be diagnostic. It has been decided to surrender Permit No. 64.


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
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
