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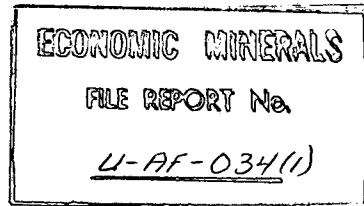

Re: Quartz Mineral Exploration Permit No. 75

Quartz Mineral Exploration Permit No. 75 has recently been terminated and in accordance with the regulations, I am submitting the following report.

A test hole was drilled on this permit in order to test existing sand horizons for the presence of uranium oxide.

The following is a summary of the general information pertaining to the test hole:

LOCATION: Lsd. 10, Sec. 2, Twp. 72, Rge. 18 W4M

CO-ORDINATES: South 1530 feet, West 1990 feet.

LICENCE NO: 35452

TOTAL DEPTH: 697 feet

TERMINAL FORMATION: Fish Scales

COMPLETION DATE: January 16, 1969

ABANDONMENT PLUGS: 260 feet to surface

LOGS: Gamma, Resistivity, SP

CORES: 661' - 697' (36 feet)

The logs did not indicate the presence of uranium oxide and a subsequent examination of the samples and core in Casper, Wyoming, confirmed the results of the logging program. A copy of the log has been attached to this report.

With respect to the costs incurred in this project it should be stated here that several properties were drilled under the same drilling contract and therefore, it has been necessary to pro-rate a portion of the total costs back to this particular permit. The amounts listed below are the pro-rated costs.



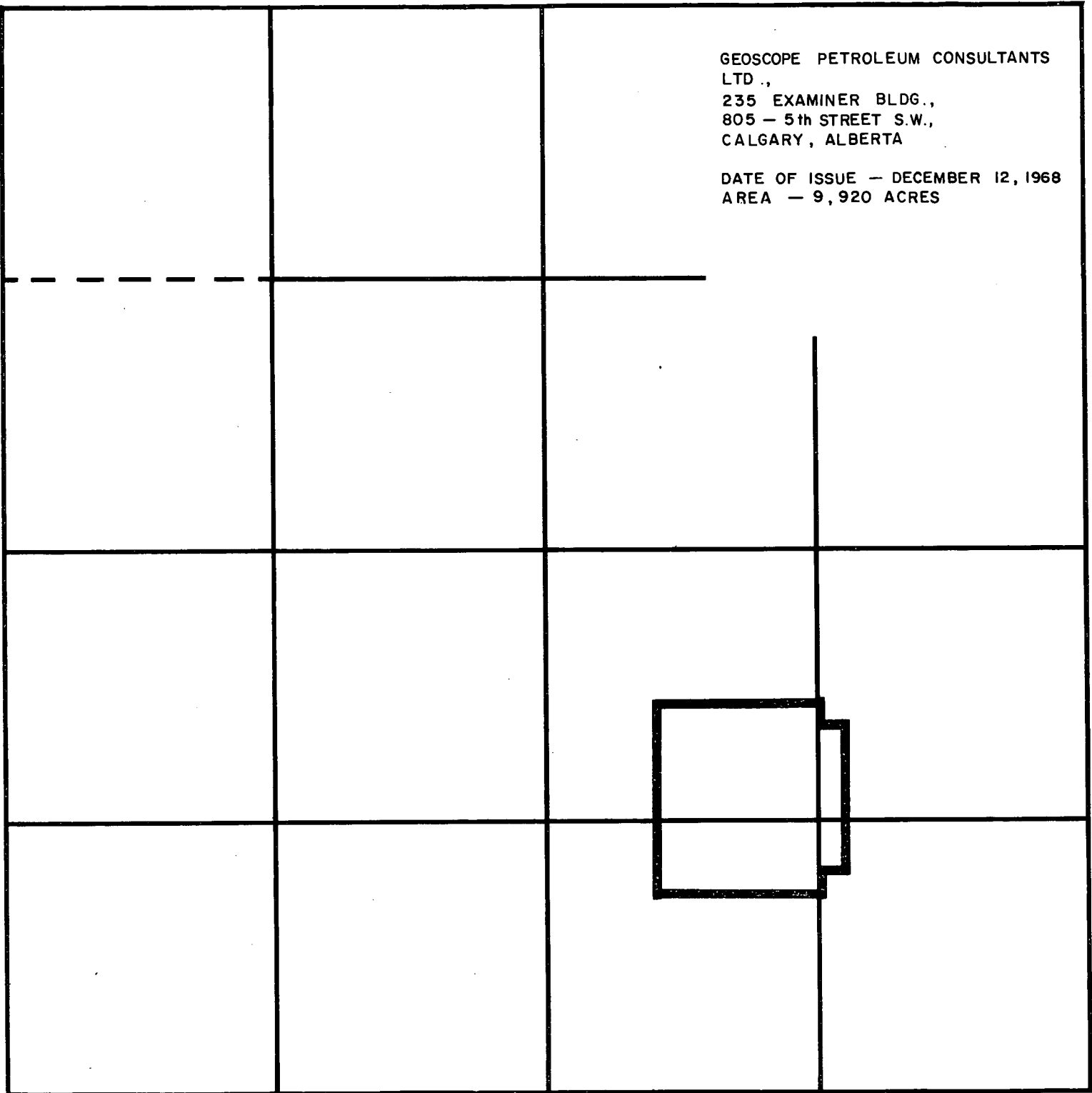

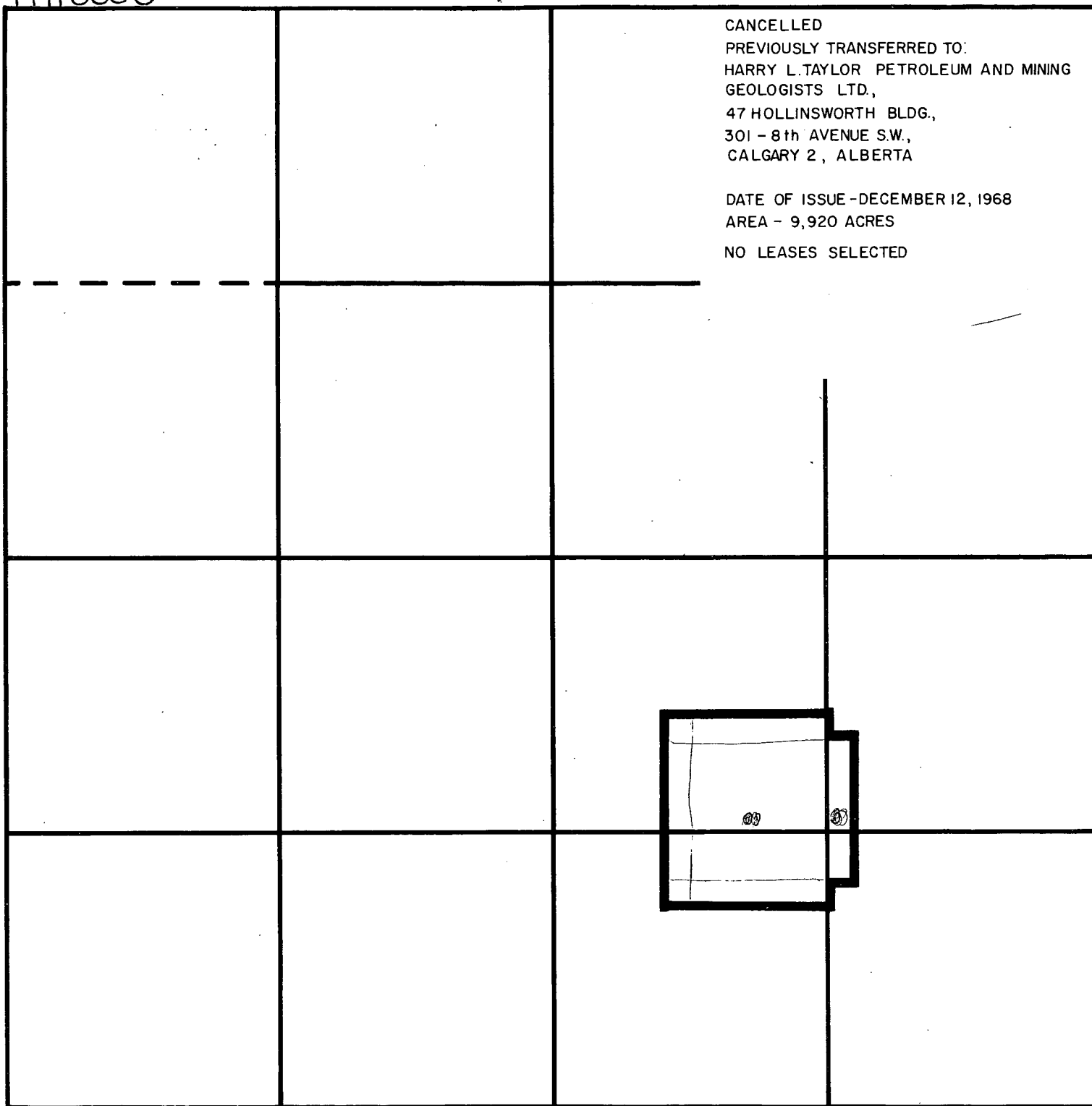
